1. Ordinance approving M.P. Land Trust's Request to Amend the Zoning Ordinance Text Relative to the Definitions of Business Development and Shopping Center and Freestanding Signs for these Uses:

Applicant Richard Parrish and Representative Rolf Schilling were present to answer questions. Development Services Director Tom Redmond noted that the Planning Commission considered this application at its meeting of July 7 and voted 8-0 to recommend approval of the text amendments.

Flanagan seconded, that the Council adopt an ordinance amending 15-2G of the Zoning Ordinance by redefining business development and shopping center and allowing a business development to have a freestanding sign.
