



## LOCAL LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION

June 7, 2005

The Local Liquor Control Commission held a meeting on Wednesday, June 7, 2005, in the City Council Chambers, 200 S. Illinois Avenue. Chairman Brad Cole called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with the following-named members of the Commission present/absent:

### 1. **Roll Call**

Also present were City Clerk Janet M. Vaught, City Manager Jeff Doherty and various members of the City's administrative staff.

### 2. **Approval of Minutes**

C. McDaniel moved, C. Wissmann seconded, that the Commission approve the minutes of the Liquor Commission meeting held on April 13, 2005. VOTE: Ayes: Fritzler, Wissmann, Haynes, Jack, Simon, McDaniel and Cole. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

### 3. **Consideration of Request to Expand the Licensed Premises of Newell House, 201 E. Main Street**

Licensee Dan Terry was present to answer questions. The City Clerk noted that the LAB and Staff Liquor Advisory Committee recommended approval of the expansion contingent upon payment of any additional license fee (if necessary) and approvals by the Health Department, Fire Department and Building and Neighborhood Services.

S. Simon moved, C. Wissmann seconded, that the Council approve the expansion of the licensed premises of Newell House, 201 E. Main Street, contingent upon receipt of all outstanding items. VOTE: Ayes: Fritzler, Wissmann, Haynes, Jack, Simon, McDaniel and Cole. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

### 4. **Local Liquor Control Commission Case No. 2005-01: Stephen-Thomas Hoffmann Enterprises, Inc., d/b/a Warehouse Liquor Mart**

Chairman Brad Cole, who served as Hearing Officer, presented his Report and Recommendation (Exhibit LC-A-6-7-05).

C. Wissmann moved, S. Simon seconded, that the Commission accept the Findings of Fact contained in the Report and Recommendation of the Hearing Officer. VOTE: Ayes: Fritzler, Wissmann, Haynes, Jack, Simon, McDaniel and Cole. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

C. Wissmann moved, J. Fritzler seconded, that the Commission accept the Penalty contained in the Report. (Letter of Reprimand and \$33 in hearing costs). VOTE: Ayes: Fritzler, Wissmann, Haynes, Jack, Simon, McDaniel and Cole. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

**5. Local Liquor Control Commission Case No. 2005-02: Pinch Penny Pub., Inc., d/b/a Pinch Penny Liquors**

Chairman Brad Cole, who served as Hearing Officer, presented his Report and Recommendation (Exhibit LC-B-6-7-05).

S. Simon moved, S. Haynes seconded, that the Commission accept the Findings of Fact contained in the Report and Recommendation of the Hearing Officer. VOTE: Ayes: Fritzler, Wissmann, Haynes, Jack, Simon, McDaniel and Cole. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

S. Simon moved, J. Fritzler seconded, that the Commission reject the recommendation for penalty contained in the report and issue a fine of \$250 plus \$22 in hearing costs. VOTE: Ayes: Fritzler, Wissmann, Haynes, Jack and Simon. Nays: McDaniel and Cole. Motion declared carried.

**6. Local Liquor Control Commission Case No. 2005-03: Karco, Inc., d/b/a One Stop**

Chairman Brad Cole, who served as Hearing Officer, presented his Report and Recommendation (Exhibit LC-C-6-7-05).

S. Haynes moved, S. Simon seconded, that the Commission accept the Findings of Fact contained in the Report and Recommendation of the Hearing Officer. VOTE: Ayes: Fritzler, Wissmann, Haynes, Jack, Simon, McDaniel and Cole. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

S. Simon moved, C. Wissmann seconded, that the Commission accept the Penalty contained in the Report. (Letter of Reprimand, \$200 fine and \$56 in hearing costs). VOTE: Ayes: Wissmann, Jack, Simon, McDaniel and Cole. Nays: Fritzler and Haynes. Motion declared carried.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting was declared adjourned at 7:28 p.m.
