



LOCAL LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION

February 21, 2006

The Local Liquor Control Commission held a meeting on Tuesday, February 21, 2006, in the City Council Chambers, 200 S. Illinois Avenue. Chairman Brad Cole called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with the following-named members of the Commission present/absent:

1. Roll Call

2. Approval of Minutes

C. Wissmann moved, S. Haynes seconded, that the Commission approve the minutes of the Liquor Commission meeting held on January 17, 2006. VOTE: Ayes: L. Jack, S. Simon, C. McDaniel, J. Fritzler, C. Wissmann, S. Haynes and B. Cole. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

3. Consideration of an application for a Class A2 liquor license for Andrea Barclay and William O. Cook, as Partners, d/b/a Global Gourmet, 102 E. Jackson

Applicants Andrea Barclay and William Cook were present to answer questions. The City Clerk noted that the Liquor Advisory Board had recommended approval contingent upon receipt of outstanding items: smoke-free affidavit, lease or deed for the property, affidavit of server training, proof of dram shop and liability insurance, copy of health permit, retailer's occupation tax number, proof of in-city residency for the applicants and approvals from the Fire Department and Building and Neighborhood Services.

S. Simon moved, C. McDaniel seconded, that the Commission approve the Class A2 liquor license for Andrea Barclay and William Cook, as Partners, d/b/a Global Gourmet, 102 E. Jackson Street, contingent upon receipt of all outstanding items. VOTE: Ayes: L. Jack, S. Simon, C. McDaniel, J. Fritzler, C. Wissmann, S. Haynes and B. Cole. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

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4. Consideration of the transfer of the Class A2 liquor license for Show-Me's, 1013 E. Main Street, from LRC of Carbondale, LLC, to SHSH Restaurant, LLC

Applicant Steven Hazlett Sr. was present to answer questions. The City Clerk noted that the Liquor Advisory Board had recommended approval of this license contingent upon receipt of outstanding items. The only outstanding item is the retailer's occupation tax number.

S. Haynes moved, S. Simon seconded, that the Commission approve the transfer of the Class A2 liquor license for Show-Me's, 1013 E. Main Street, from LRC of Carbondale, LLC, to SHSH Restaurant, LLC, contingent upon receipt of outstanding items. VOTE: Ayes: L. Jack, S. Simon, C. McDaniel, J. Fritzler, C. Wissmann, S. Haynes and B. Cole. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

5. Consideration of an application for a Class A1 liquor license for JeTaime Rachatanavin, an Individual, d/b/a Thai Taste of Carbondale, 100 S. Illinois Avenue

JeTaime Rachatanavin was present to answer questions. The City Clerk noted that the Liquor Advisory Board had recommended approval of this license contingent upon receipt of outstanding items: retailer's occupation tax number, proof of in-city residency for the applicant, affidavit of server training, lease or deed for the property, proof of dram shop and liability insurance, copy of health permit and approvals from the Fire Department and Building and Neighborhood Services.

S. Simon moved, L. Jack seconded, that the Commission approve the Class A1 liquor license for JeTaime Rachatanavin, an Individual, d/b/a Thai Taste of Carbondale, 100 S. Illinois Avenue, contingent upon receipt of outstanding items. VOTE: Ayes: L. Jack, S. Simon, C. McDaniel, J. Fritzler, C. Wissmann, S. Haynes and B. Cole. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

4. Review of Second Quarter Reports from the Police Department, Fire Department and Building and Neighborhood Services for License Year 2005-2006

C. Wissmann moved, S. Haynes seconded, that the Commission accept the Second Quarter Reports for License Year 2005-2006 from Building and Neighborhood Services, the Fire Department and the Police Department and place them on file. VOTE: Ayes: L. Jack, S. Simon, C. McDaniel, J. Fritzler, C. Wissmann, S. Haynes and B. Cole. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.
