



## LOCAL LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION

January 17, 2006

The Local Liquor Control Commission held a meeting on Tuesday, January 17, 2006, in the City Council Chambers, 200 S. Illinois Avenue. Chairman Brad Cole called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with the following-named members of the Commission present/absent:

### 1. Roll Call

### 2. Approval of Minutes

S. Simon moved, C. McDaniel seconded, that the Commission approve the minutes of the Liquor Commission meeting held on November 15, 2005. VOTE: Ayes: C. Wissmann, S. Haynes, L. Jack, S. Simon, C. McDaniel, J. Fritzler and B. Cole. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

### 3. Consideration of an application for the transfer of the Class A2 liquor license for Booby's Submarine Sandwiches at 408 S. Illinois Avenue from Booby's Submarine Sandwiches, Ltd., to Gilmore and Gilmore, Inc

Applicant Howard Spinner was present to answer questions. The City Clerk noted that the Liquor Advisory Board had recommended approval of the issuance of the license contingent upon receipt of all outstanding items. Outstanding items included the two remaining criminal history checks, lease or deed for the property, retailer's occupation tax number, certificate of good standing or certificate of incorporation, affidavit of server training, proof of dram shop and liability insurance, copy of the health permit and approvals from the Fire Department and Building and Neighborhood Services.

S. Simon moved, L. Jack seconded, that the Commission approve the transfer of the Class A2 liquor license for Booby's Submarine Sandwiches, 408 S. Illinois Avenue, from Booby's Submarine Sandwiches, Ltd. to Gilmore and Gilmore, Inc., contingent upon receipt of all outstanding items. VOTE: Ayes: C. Wissmann, S. Haynes, L. Jack, S. Simon, C. 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**4. Consideration of an application for a Class A2 liquor license for Kathy R. Pierce, an Individual, d/b/a LBJ's Steakhouse, 218 N. Illinois Avenue**

Kathy Pierce was present to answer questions. The City Clerk noted that the Liquor Advisory Board had recommended approval of the issuance of the license contingent upon receipt of all outstanding items. Outstanding items included lease or deed for the property, retailer's occupation tax number, affidavit of server training, proof of dram shop and liability insurance, copy of the health permit and approvals from the Fire Department and Building and Neighborhood Services.

J. Fritzler moved, S. Simon seconded, that the Commission approve the issuance of the Class A2 liquor license for Kathy R. Pierce, an Individual, d/b/a LBJ's Steakhouse, 218 N. Jack seconded, that the Commission accept the First Quarter Reports for License Year 2005-2006 from Building and Neighborhood Services, the Fire Department and the Police Department and place them on file.
