



LOCAL LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION
February 20, 2007

The Local Liquor Control Commission held a meeting on Tuesday, February 20, 2007, in the City Council Chambers, 200 S. Illinois Avenue. Chairman Brad Cole called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with the following-named members of the Commission present/absent:

1. Roll Call

Present: Commissioner Joel Fritzler, Commissioner Chris Wissmann, Commissioner Steven Haynes, Commissioner Sheila Simon, Commissioner Corene McDaniel and Chairman Brad Cole.

Absent: Commissioner Lance Jack (entered at 7:02 p.m.)

Also present were City Clerk Janet M. Vaught, City Manager Jeffrey W. Doherty and various members of the City's administrative staff.

2. Approval of Minutes

S. Simon moved, C. McDaniel seconded, that the Commission approve the minutes of the meeting held on January 16, 2007. VOTE: Ayes: J. Fritzler, C. Wissmann, S. Haynes, S. Simon, C. McDaniel and B. Cole. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

3. Consideration of a Class B2 liquor license for Nights Over Egypt Restaurant and Lounge LLC d/b/a Nights Over Egypt Restaurant and Lounge, 281 North Illinois Avenue

Corporate President Kathy Pierce was present to answer questions. The City Clerk said that outstanding items included lease or deed for the property in the name of the LLC, the retailer's occupation tax number, affidavit of server training and approvals from the Health Department, Fire Department and Building and Neighborhood Services.

In response to Commission inquiry, Ms. Pierce said the current hours of the restaurant at 5pm to 2am on Thursday, Friday and Saturday and that the proposed hours for the bar will be 9pm to 2am Thursday, Friday and Saturday. She also said that she understands the regulations of the Liquor Code and will comply with those regulations.

S. Simon moved, S. Haynes seconded, that the Commission approve the issuance of a Class B2 liquor license for Nights Over Egypt Restaurant and Lounge LLC d/b/a Nights Over Egypt Restaurant and Lounge, 218 North Illinois Avenue, contingent upon receipt of all outstanding items. VOTE: Ayes: J. Fritzler, S. Haynes, L. Jack, S. Simon and C. McDaniel. Nays: C. Wissmann and B. Cole. Motion declared carried.

4. Consideration of the transfer of the Class A2 liquor license for Booby's Submarine Sandwiches, 406-406 South Illinois Avenue, from Booby's Submarine Sandwiches Ltd. to B.S.S. Carbondale Inc.

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Corporate President Lindsey Fisher was present to answer questions. The City Clerk said that outstanding items included retailer's occupation tax number, proof of dram shop and liability insurance, affidavit of server training and approvals from the Health Department, Building and Neighborhood Services and the Fire Department.

S. Haynes moved, C. McDaniel seconded, that the Commission approve the transfer of the Class A2 liquor license for Booby's Submarine Sandwiches, 406-408 South Illinois Avenue, from Booby's Submarine Sandwiches Ltd. to B.S.S. Carbondale Inc. pending receipt of all outstanding items. VOTE: Ayes: C. Wissmann, S. Haynes, L. Jack, S. Simon, C. McDaniel and B. Cole. Nays: J. Fritzler. Motion declared carried.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting was declared adjourned at 7:20 p.m..
