



LOCAL LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION

March 20, 2007

The Local Liquor Control Commission held a meeting on Tuesday, March 20, 2007, in the City Council Chambers, 200 S. Illinois Avenue. Chairman Brad Cole called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with the following-named members of the Commission present/absent:

1. Roll Call

Present: Commissioner Steven Haynes, Commissioner Lance Jack, Commissioner Sheila Simon, Commissioner Corene McDaniel, Commissioner Joel Fritzler, Commissioner Chris Wissmann and Chairman Brad Cole.

Absent: None.

Also present were City Clerk Janet M. Vaught, City Manager Jeffrey Doherty and members of the City's administrative staff.

2. Approval of Minutes

S. Simon moved, S. Haynes seconded, that the Commission approve the minutes of the meeting held on February 20, 2007. VOTE: Ayes: S. Haynes, L. Jack, S. Simon, C. McDaniel, J. Fritzler, C. Wissmann and B. Cole. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

3. Consideration of an application for a Class B2 liquor license for Andrea Barclay and William Cook, as Partners, d/b/a Global Gourmet, 102 East Jackson Street

Applicants Andrea Barclay and William Cook were present to answer questions. The City Clerk noted that the applicants currently hold a Class A2 license at this location. The only items outstanding were approvals from Building and Neighborhood Services, the Fire Department and the Health Department and payment of the fee for the outdoor patio area.

S. Haynes moved, C. McDaniel seconded, that the Commission approve the issuance of a Class B2 liquor license for Andrea Barclay and William Cook, as Partners, d/b/a Global Gourmet, 102 East Jackson Street, including approval of the outdoor patio area, contingent upon receipt of favorable inspections and payment of the fee for the outdoor patio area. VOTE: Ayes: S. Haynes, L. Jack, S. Simon, C. McDaniel, J. Fritzler, C. Wissmann and B. Cole. Nays: None. Motion declared carried

4. Consideration of the transfer of the Class B2 liquor license for Stix Bar & Billiards, 517 South Illinois Avenue, from Stix Bar & Billiards, Inc. to Knoob Enterprises, Inc.

Applicant Greg Knoob was present to answer questions. The City Clerk noted that outstanding items include lease or deed for the property, certificate of good standing, retailer's occupation tax number, proof of dram shop and liability insurance, affidavit of server training and approvals from the Health Department, Fire Department and Building and Neighborhood Services.
