



LOCAL LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION

May 11, 2007

The Local Liquor Control Commission held a meeting on Friday, May 11, 2007, in the Mayor's Conference Room in City Hall, 200 S. Illinois Avenue. Chairman Brad Cole called the meeting to order at 12:00 p.m. with the following-named members of the Commission present/absent:

1. Roll Call

Present: Commissioner Chris Wissmann, Commissioner Steven Haynes, Commissioner Lance Jack and Chairman Brad Cole. Commissioner Corene McDaniel attended telephonically.

Absent: Commissioner Joel Fritzler and Commissioner Sheila Simon.

Also present were City Clerk Janet M. Vaught, City Manager Jeffrey Doherty, Councilwoman-Elect Mary Pohlmann and members of the City's administrative staff.

2. Approval of Minutes

C. Wissmann moved, L. Jack seconded, that the Commission approve the minutes of the April 24, 2007, Liquor Commission minutes. VOTE: Ayes: C. McDaniel, C. Wissmann, S. Haynes, L. Jack and B. Cole. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

3. Consideration of Request to Expand the License Premises of the Upside Downtown, 213 East Main Street

Applicant Dan Terry was present. The City Clerk noted that Mr. Terry indicated at the Liquor Advisory Board that he was withdrawing his request for expansion into 209 East Main Street and was putting the request for a beer garden on indefinite hold. The only items outstanding are approvals from the Health Department, Fire Department and Building and Neighborhood Services.

S. Haynes moved, L. Jack seconded, that the Commission approve the expansion of the Upside Downtown into 215 East Main Street contingent upon approvals from the Health Department, Fire Department and Building and Neighborhood Services. VOTE: Ayes: C. McDaniel, C. Wissmann, S. Haynes, L. Jack and B. Cole. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

4. Consideration of an application for a Class A2 liquor license for Makon Hap, Inc., d/b/a Fujiyama Restaurant, 715 North Giant City Road

Applicant Justin Qiu was present. The City Clerk noted that Makon Hap had been granted a 180-Day Permit for license in October, but the Permit expired on April 15, 2007. Therefore, the applicant has reactivated his liquor license application. Outstanding items include affidavit of server training, a manager's statement for a manager who lives inside the City limits and

approvals from the Health Department, Fire Department and Building and Neighborhood Services.

L. Jack moved, C. Wissmann seconded, that the Commission approve the Class A2 liquor license for Makon Hap, Inc., d/b/a Fujiyama Restaurant, 715 N. Giant City Road, contingent upon receipt of outstanding items. VOTE: Ayes: C. McDaniel, C. Wissmann, S. Haynes, L. Jack and B. Cole. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.
