



LOCAL LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION

October 2, 2007

The Local Liquor Control Commission held a meeting on Tuesday, October 2, 2007, in City Council Chambers, Room 108 of the Civic Center, 200 S. Illinois Avenue. Chairman Brad Cole called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with the following-named members of the Commission present/absent:

1. Roll Call

Absent: None.

Also present were City Clerk Janet M. Vaught, City Manager Jeffrey Doherty and various members of the City's administrative staff.

2. Approval of Minutes

C. Wissmann moved, J. Fritzler seconded, that the Commission approve the minutes of the July 17, 2007, Liquor Commission meeting. VOTE: Ayes: S. Haynes, L. Jack, J. Fritzler, C. McDaniel, M. Pohlmann, C. Wissmann and B. Cole. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

3. Consideration of an application for a Class A2 liquor license for Mi Pueblito, Inc., d/b/a Mi Pueblito Mexican Restaurant, 100 North Glenview Drive #206

Applicant Martin Mauricio was present to answer questions. Also present was Mr. Mauricio's business associate, Hector Barron, who was available to serve as an interpreter. The City Clerk noted that outstanding items included the balance of the license fee, lease or deed for the property, proof of dram shop and liability insurance, affidavit of server training, copy of the health permit and approvals from the Fire Department and Building and Neighborhood Services.

L. Jack moved, C. McDaniel seconded, that the Commission approve the Class A2 liquor license for Mi Pueblito, Inc., d/b/a Mi Pueblito Mexican Restaurant, 100 North Glenview Drive #206 pending receipt of all outstanding items. VOTE: Ayes: S. Haynes, L. Jack, J. Fritzler, C. McDaniel, M. Pohlmann, C. Wissmann and B. Cole. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

4. Consideration of request from The Cellar, 101 West Monroe Street, to add a beer garden

Owner/applicants Paul and Michelle Stokes were present to answer questions. Paul Stokes indicated that he was aware that the State had not yet finalized the regulations regarding the Smoke Free Act and whether to not the beer garden is built depends, in part, on what the final regulations say about smoking in beer gardens. Commissioner Pohlmann noted that the proposed Regulations are available in the Illinois Register and there is a 45 day comment period currently underway.

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L. Jack moved, J. Fritzler seconded, that the Commission approve the beer garden area for The Cellar contingent upon approvals from the Health Department, Fire Department and Building and Neighborhood Services. VOTE: Ayes: S. Haynes, L. Jack, J. Fritzler, C. McDaniel, M. Pohlmann, C. Wissmann and B. Cole. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

5. Consideration of a Class D liquor license for Carbondale Hospitality LLC d/b/a Days Inn, 800 East Main Street

Applicant Ramneesh Prabhakar was present to answer questions. The City Clerk noted that the outstanding items were the balance of the license fee, lease or deed for the property, certificate of incorporation or certificate of good standing, proof of dram shop insurance, copy of the health permit, affidavit of server training, retailer's occupation tax number and approvals from the Health Department, Fire Department and Building and Neighborhood Services.

C. Wissmann moved, M. Pohlmann seconded, that the Commission approve the Class D liquor license for Carbondale Hospitality LLC d/b/a Day's Inn, 800 East Main Street, contingent upon receipt of all outstanding items. VOTE: Ayes: S. Haynes, L. Jack, J. Fritzler, C. McDaniel, M. Pohlmann, C. Wissmann and B. Cole. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

6. Review of Fourth Quarter (Final) Reports for License Year 2006-2007 from the Police Department, Fire Department and Building and Neighborhood Services

M. Pohlmann moved, L. Jack seconded, that the Commission accept the Fourth Quarter (Final) Reports for License Year 2006-2007 from Building and Neighborhood Services, the Fire Department and the Police Department and place them on file. VOTE: Ayes: S. Haynes, L. Jack, J. Fritzler, C. McDaniel, M. Pohlmann, C. Wissmann and B. Cole. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting was declared adjourned at 7:13 p.m.
