

City Council of the City of Carbondale, Illinois
Public Hearing on Proposed Vacation of a Portion of the North-South Alley
Located Between East Jackson Street and East Oak Street
June 10, 2008

The City Council of the City of Carbondale, Illinois, held a public hearing on Tuesday, June 10, 2008 in City Council Chambers, 200 S. Illinois Avenue, for the purpose of soliciting comments on the proposed vacation of a north-south alley located between East Jackson Street and East Oak Street. Mayor Cole called the public hearing to order at 7:32 p.m. with the following-named members of the City Council present/absent:

Mayor Cole noted that Praise Central Church of Deliverance has requested that a portion of a north-south alley located between East Jackson and East Oak Street be vacated. The alley requested for vacation is an oil and chip surface maintained by the City. He noted that this item will be discussed later under General Business.

Mayor Cole invited comments or questions from the public. There was no one in the audience who indicated a desire to speak on this issue. Mayor Cole twice repeated his invitation for public comments or questions. Again, there was no one who indicated a desire to speak during this public hearing.

There being no further comments or questions at this hearing, Mayor Cole declared the public hearing closed at 7:33 p.m.
