



LOCAL LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION

March 4, 2008

The Local Liquor Control Commission held a meeting on Tuesday, March 4, 2008, in City Council Chambers, Room 108 of the Civic Center, 200 S. Illinois Avenue. Chairman Brad Cole called the meeting to order at 7:03 p.m. with the following-named members of the Commission present/absent:

Attorney Alfred Sanders was present representing the licensee, Knoob Enterprises, Inc.. Attorney Sanders presented an oral argument and supporting documents on why the licensee's appeal should be granted.

Attorney Jamie Snyder, Assistant City Attorney for the City of Carbondale, presented an oral argument on why the City should sustain the City's Motion to Strike the licensee's Notice of Appeal.

McDaniel seconded, that the Commission approve the transfer of the Class B2 liquor license for Key West, 1108 West Main Street, from Key West On Your Mind, Inc. to Uffleman Corporation contingent upon receipt of all outstanding items.
