



**LOCAL LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION**  
**October 21, 2008**

The Local Liquor Control Commission held a meeting on Tuesday, October 21, 2008, in City Council Chambers, Room 108 of the Civic Center, 200 S. Illinois Avenue. Chairman Brad Cole called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with the following-named members of the Commission present/absent:

**1. Roll Call**

Absent: None

Also present were City Clerk Janet M. Vaught, City Manager Allen Gill and various members of the City's administrative staff.

**2. Approval of Minutes**

M. Pohlmann moved, J. Fritzler seconded, that the Commission approve the minutes of the Liquor Commission meetings held on June 10 and June 17, 2008. VOTE: Ayes: J. Fritzler, C. McDaniel, M. Pohlmann, C. Wissmann, S. Haynes, L. Jack and B. Cole. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

**3. Consideration of an application for a Class B2 liquor license for John Karayanis, an Individual, d/b/a The Underground Pub, 717 South University**

Applicant John Karayanis was present to answer questions. The City Clerk noted the outstanding items: balance of the license fee, lease or deed for the property, retailer's occupation tax certificate, proof of dram shop and liability insurance, affidavit of server training and approvals from the Health Department, Fire Department and Building and Neighborhood Services.

S. Haynes moved, C. McDaniel seconded, that the Council approve the Class B2 liquor license for John Karayanis, an Individual d/b/a The Underground Pub, 717 South University, pending receipt of all outstanding items. VOTE: Ayes: J. Fritzler, C. McDaniel, M. Pohlmann, C. Wissmann, S. Haynes and L. Jack. Nays: B. Cole. Motion declared carried.

**4. Consideration of request for a Beer Garden for Club Traz, 213 East Main Street**

Applicant Dan Terry was not present and there was no one else who indicated that they were present to represent the applicant.

The City Clerk noted that the beer garden was recommended for approval contingent upon the compliance with any recommendations coming from Development Services. The Fire Department and Building and Neighborhood Services made recommendations for modification to the plan and the applicant has agreed to make the recommended modifications.

S. Haynes moved, L. Jack seconded, that the Commission approve the beer garden area for Club Traz, 213 East Main Street, contingent upon the modification of the design of the beer garden to satisfy the concerns of the Development Services Department and the Fire Department. VOTE: Ayes: J. Fritzler, C. McDaniel, M. Pohlmann, C. Wissmann, S. Haynes, L. Jack and B. Cole. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

**6. Consideration of Fourth Quarter Reports from the Police Department, Fire Department and Building and Neighborhood Services**

M. Pohlmann moved, S. Haynes seconded, that the Commission accept the Fourth Quarter Reports for License Year 2007-2008 from Building and Neighborhood Services, the Fire Department and the Police Department and place them on file. DISCUSSION: Commissioner Fritzler noted that a couple of the license holders had decreased their numbers of arrests during the fourth quarter. Councilman Jack stated that he would like to see if there could be more timely notification of arrests provided to the liquor license holders. Chairman Cole said that would be looked into. VOTE: Ayes: J. Fritzler, C. McDaniel, M. Pohlmann, C. Wissmann, S. Haynes, L. Jack and B. Cole. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

**7. Adjournment**

There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting was declared adjourned at 7:09 p.m.
