Public Hearing on Proposed Vacation of a North/South Alley Between
East Burke Street and East Fisher Street and Bounded by
North Pierce Street and North Wall Street
October 7, 2008

The City Council of the City of Carbondale, Illinois, held a public hearing on Tuesday, October 7, 2008, in the Civic Center, 200 South Illinois Avenue, for the purpose of soliciting comments on a proposed vacation of a north/south alley between East Burke Street and East Fisher Street and bounded by North Pierce Street and North Wall Street. Mayor Brad Cole called the public hearing to order at 7:02 p.m. with the following-named members of the City Council present/absent:

Mayor Cole noted that a request had been received to vacate a portion of a north/south alley located between East Burke and East Fisher Streets. Planning staff is recommending that the entire alley be considered for vacation. Mayor Cole noted that the matter will be considered later in the City Council agenda for action.

Mayor Cole invited comments or questions from the public. There was no one who indicated a desire to speak. Mayor Cole twice repeated his invitation for public comments; again, there was no one who wished to speak.

There being no one else who wished to speak during this public hearing, the Mayor declared the hearing closed at 7:03 p.m.
