



LOCAL LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION
February 17, 2009

The Local Liquor Control Commission held a meeting on Tuesday, February 17, 2009, in City Council Chambers, Room 108 of the Civic Center, 200 S. Illinois Avenue. Chairman Brad Cole called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with the following-named members of the Commission present/absent:

2. Approval of Minutes

3. Consideration of a Class F1 liquor license for the 13th Annual Carbondale Main Street Pig Out scheduled for September 18 and 19, 2009, in the 710 Bookstore, B & A Travel and Campus Shopping Center Parking Lots

Meghan Cole was present representing Carbondale Main Street. The City Clerk noted that the only outstanding item is proof of dram shop and liability insurance.

Fritzler seconded, that the Commission approve the Class F1 liquor license for Carbondale Main Street Pig Out on September 18 and 19, 2009, contingent upon receipt of dram shop and liability insurance. 4. Consideration of an application for an A2 liquor license for Stadium Grille, Inc., d/b/a Stadium Grille, 309 East Main Street

Applicant Gary Strothmann was present to answer questions. The City Clerk noted that outstanding items included are the balance of the license fee, lease or deed for the property, proof of dram shop and liability insurance, copy of health permit, affidavit of server training, retailer's occupation tax number and approvals from Building and Neighborhood Services and the Fire Department.
