For more than fifty years Downtown has been thought of as a student neighborhood. That era is over.






Carbondale Population 1880 - 2010




SIUC downsizing affected Jackson County's economy




SIU staff downsizing took biggest toll in Carbondale and Jackson County






Reconceptualize downtown neighborhoods

- Create an overlay district
 - The City of Carbondale could create an “overlay district” along the Fiber Optic networks that course near downtown and our near in neighborhoods. A change in code for Accessory dwelling unit (ADU) zoning would be allowed for homeowners.
 - Special incentives owners who “live over the shop” could be instituted. Very high speed internet may lead to ultra-light manufacturing such as 3D printing and other digitally-based products.
 - Design standards could help reclaim the historic quality of the core neighborhoods.
