



LOCAL LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION

February 9, 2010

The Local Liquor Control Commission held a meeting on Tuesday, February 9, 2010, in City Council Chambers, Room 108 of the Civic Center, 200 S. Illinois Avenue. Chairman Brad Cole called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with the following-named members of the Commission present/absent:

1. Roll Call

Also present were City Clerk Janet M. Vaught, City Manager Allen Gill and various members of the City's administrative staff.

2. Approval of Minutes

J. Fritzler moved, C. Wissmann seconded, that the Commission approve the minutes of the Liquor Control Commission meeting held on January 19, 2010. VOTE: Ayes: C. McDaniel, C. Wissmann, L. Jack, J. Fritzler and B. Cole. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

3. Consideration of an Application for a Class A2 Liquor License for ERJ Dining III, LLC d/b/a Chili's Grill and Bar, 1240 East Main Street

Todd Anderson, Area Director for Chili's, was present to answer questions. The City Clerk noted that the Liquor Advisory Board had recommended approval of the liquor license for Chili's contingent upon receipt of outstanding items. Outstanding items are balance of the license fee, lease or deed for the property, retailer's occupation tax number, proof of dram shop and liability insurance, appointment of a manager or agent who resides within the Carbondale city limits, affidavit of server training and approvals from the Health Department, Fire Department and Building and Neighborhood Services.

C. McDaniel moved, L. Jack seconded, that the Commission approve the Class A2 liquor license for ERJ Dining III, LLC d/b/a/ Chili's Grill and Bar, 1240 East Main Street, pending receipt of all outstanding items. VOTE: Ayes: C. McDaniel, C. Wissmann, L. Jack, J. Fritzler and B. Cole. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

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4. Consideration of Request from Pagliai's Pizza and Pasta of Carbondale, Inc., for the Transfer of the Location of the Licensed Premises *from 515 South Illinois Avenue to 509 South Illinois Avenue* and Change of License Classification *from Class A1 to Class A2*

Tim and Melissa Parsons were present to answer questions. The City Clerk noted that the Liquor Advisory Board had recommended approval of both the transfer of location and the "upgrade" to a Class A2 liquor license contingent upon receipt of outstanding items. Outstanding items are

balance of the license fee, lease or deed for the new location, appointment of a manager or agent who resides within the Carbondale city limits and approvals from the Health Department, Fire Department and Building and Neighborhood Services.

C. Wissmann moved, L. Jack seconded, that the Commission approve the transfer of the liquor license for Pagliai's Pizza and Pasta of Carbondale, Inc., from 515 South Illinois Avenue to 509 South Illinois Avenue and approve the requested change in classification from a Class A1 to a Class A2 license when the move to the new location is completed, both contingent upon receipt of all outstanding items. VOTE: Ayes: C. McDaniel, C. Wissmann, L. Jack, J. Fritzler and B. Cole. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

4. Adjournment

There being no further business to come before the Commission, Chairman Cole declared the meeting adjourned at 7:07 p.m.
