



LOCAL LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION
October 5, 2010

The Local Liquor Control Commission held a meeting on Tuesday, October 5, 2010, in City Council Chambers, Room 108 of the Civic Center, 200 S. Illinois Avenue. Chairman Brad Cole called the meeting to order at 8:08 p.m. with the following-named members of the Commission present/absent:

1. Roll Call

Also present were City Clerk Janet M. Vaught, City Manager Allen Gill and various members of the City's administrative staff. (NOTE: Commissioner Lance Jack resigned his position on the Carbondale City Council and the Local Liquor Control Commission immediately preceding this meeting.)

2. Approval of Minutes

M. Pohlmann moved, C. McDaniel seconded, that the Commission approve the minutes of the Liquor Control Commission meeting held on August 3, 2010. VOTE: Ayes: J. Fritzler, C. McDaniel, M. Pohlmann, C. Wissmann, S. Haynes and B. Cole. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

3. Consideration of an Application for a Class D1 Liquor License for William D. Jones, an Individual, d/b/a Hundley House, 601 West Main Street

Applicant William D. Jones was present to answer questions. The City Clerk enumerated the outstanding items: proof of residency for the owner, lease or deed for the property, proof of dram shop and liability insurance, retailer's occupation tax certificate, affidavit of server training, copy of health permit and approvals from Building and Neighborhood Services and the Fire Department.

S. Haynes moved, C. Wissmann seconded, that the Commission approve the Class D1 liquor license for William D. Jones, An Individual, d/b/a Hundley House, 601 West Main Street, contingent upon receipt of outstanding items. VOTE: Ayes: J. Fritzler, C. McDaniel, M. Pohlmann, C. Wissmann, S. Haynes and B. Cole. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

4. Consideration of an Application for a Class A1 Liquor License for DiMaggio's Pizza of Jackson County, LLC d/b/a DiMaggio's Pizza, 1040 East Walnut Street

Maria "Angie" DiMaggio was present to answer questions. The City Clerk enumerated the outstanding items: balance of the liquor license fee, certificate of good standing for the

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corporation, lease or deed for the property, proof of dram shop and liability insurance, retailer's occupation tax certificate, affidavit of server training, copy of health permit and approvals from Building and Neighborhood Services and the Fire Department.

C. McDaniel moved, C. Wissmann seconded, that the Commission approve the Class A1 liquor license for DiMaggio's Pizza of Jackson County, LLC d/b/a DiMaggio's Pizza, 1040 East Walnut Street, contingent upon receipt of outstanding items. VOTE: Ayes: J. Fritzler, C. McDaniel, M. Pohlmann, C. Wissmann, S. Haynes and B. Cole. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

5. Consideration of an application for a Class A1 liquor license for Melting Pot, Inc., d/b/a Fat Patties, 611B South Illinois Avenue

Applicant Lance D. Jack was present to answer questions. The City Clerk enumerated the outstanding items: Balance of the liquor license fee, lease or deed for the property, certificate of incorporation or certificate of good standing, proof of dram shop and liability insurance, copy of health permit and retailer's occupation tax number.

C. McDaniel moved, M. Pohlmann seconded, that the Commission approve the Class A1 liquor license for Melting Pot Inc. d/b/a Fat Patties, 611B South Illinois Avenue, contingent upon receipt of outstanding items. VOTE: Ayes: J. Fritzler, C. McDaniel, M. Pohlmann, C. Wissmann, S. Haynes and B. Cole. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

Subsequent to the vote, Commissioner Pohlmann stated that the City ordinance and State law appear incompatible with respect to a member of the City Council/Local Liquor Control Commission holding a liquor license and suggested that the Liquor Commission take a look at the issue.

6. Adjournment

There being no further business to come before the Commission, Chairman Cole declared the meeting adjourned at 8:19 p.m.
