



LOCAL LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION
April 19, 2011

The Local Liquor Control Commission held a meeting on Tuesday, April 19, 2011, in Room 103 of the Civic Center, 200 S. Illinois Avenue. Chairman Brad Cole called the meeting to order at 6:16 p.m. with the following-named members of the Commission present/absent:

1. Roll Call

2. Hearing of an Appeal of a Decision filed by Linda Parrish President of Goose Creek, Ltd. d/b/a Gatsby's II Bar and Billiards, Local Liquor Control Case 2011-01

Being an appeal on the hearing of Local Liquor Control Commission Case 2011-01 involving Goose Creek, Ltd., d/b/a Gatsby's II Bar and Billiards, which evidentiary hearing was conducted on Tuesday, March 8, 2011 before Hearing Officer Brad Cole. A copy of the notice of Hearing on Appeal, a copy of the Hearing Officer's Report and Order, a transcript of the proceedings with attached exhibits was provided to the Commission. The Hearing Officer read into the record those individuals present at the original hearing, evidence entered into the record, and action taken resulting from the hearing on March 8, 2011. Assistant City Attorney Jamie Snyder and Linda Parrish, President of Goose Creek, Ltd., d/b/a Gatsby's II Bar and Billiards, identified themselves for the record. Attorney Snyder requested that the Commission stand behind the Order entered by the Hearing Officer, but indicated that the City would not be opposed to the initial recommendation for the penalty, a written letter of reprimand and payment of all costs of the hearing, including those fees associated with the appeal, by the Licensee. Hearing Officer Brad Cole welcomed the Licensee to present evidence or to concur with the City's recommendation. The Licensee gave an explanation of her absence from the initial hearing and then began to speak on behalf of the establishment. The Hearing Officer explained that the Appeal on Hearing was not an appropriate time to give evidence for the hearing being appealed, but rather was limited to the scope of the record of the Hearing. The Licensee indicated that she concurred with the City's amended recommendation of the issuance of a letter of reprimand and all costs associated with the hearing and appeal on hearing.

S. Haynes moved, M. Pohlmann seconded, that the Commission approve the new penalty of a of a Letter of Reprimand being entered into the Licensee's permanent record, as well as responsibility of all costs associated with the hearing on March 8 and the Appeal on hearing. VOTE: Ayes: M. Pohlmann, C. Wissmann, S. Haynes, M. Neill, C. McDaniel and B. Cole.

Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

3. Adjournment

There being no further business to come before the Commission, Chairman Cole declared the meeting adjourned at 6:23 p.m.
