Public Hearing on the Proposed Sale of Property Located at 301 N. Marion Street
September 20, 2011

The City Council of the City of Carbondale, Illinois, held a public hearing on Tuesday, September 20, 2011, in City Council Chambers, 200 S. Illinois Avenue, for the purpose of soliciting comments on the proposed sale of property located at 301 N. Marion Street. Mayor Fritzler called the public hearing to order at 7:07 p.m. with the following-named members of the City Council present/absent:

Present: Councilman Chris Wissmann, Councilman Donald D. Monty, Councilwoman Jane Adams, Councilman Lance Jack, Councilman Lee M. Fronabarger, Councilwoman Corene McDaniel and Mayor Joel Fritzler.

Also present were City Clerk Rachael Moore Keehn, City Manager Allen Gill and various members of the City's administrative staff.

A notice of proposed land sale was published in the Southern Illinoisan on September 3, 2011. The City has negotiated a contract with Sorrell Kunath d/b/a Common Greens, Inc., a not-for-profit entity, for the purpose of developing the parcel as a location for the construction of community gardens. The parcel is legally known as part of Outlot 3 in the original City of Carbondale.

Mayor Fritzler invited comments or questions from the public, but no one chose to speak on the matter.

There being no comments or questions at this hearing, Mayor Fritzler declared the public hearing closed at 7:09 p.m.
