Public Hearing on the Proposed Vacation of a North/South Alley
West of 805 West Sycamore Street
July 16, 2013

The City Council of the City of Carbondale, Illinois, held a public hearing on Tuesday, July 16, 2013, in City Council Chambers, 200 S. Illinois Avenue, for the purpose of soliciting comments on the proposed vacation of a north/south alley west of 805 West Sycamore Street. Mayor Fritzler called the public hearing to order at 7:24 p.m. with the following-named members of the City Council present/absent:

Present: Councilwoman Jessica Bradshaw, Councilwoman Carolin Harvey, Councilman Donald Monty, Councilwoman Jane Adams, Councilman Lance Jack, Councilman Lee Fronabarger, and Mayor Joel Fritzler.

Absent: None.

Also present were City Clerk Jennifer Sorrell, City Manager Kevin Baity, and various members of the City's administrative staff.

City Manager Kevin Baity presented the background of the item. Mr. James Temple is requesting the vacation of the north/south alley located west of the property at 805 West Sycamore Street. The alley is 20' wide and contains an eight-inch sanitary sewer line. It also serves as the driveway for 805 West Sycamore and a point of ingress and egress for the old Coke warehouse located at 413 North Oakland Avenue. The southern portion of the alley, which extends to Pecan Street, was vacated in 1996.

Mayor Fritzler invited comments or questions from the public, but no one indicated a desire to speak on this issue. Mayor Fritzler twice repeated his request for comments or questions from the public.

There being no comments or questions at this hearing, Mayor Fritzler declared the public hearing closed at 7:27 p.m.
