

City Council of the City of Carbondale, Illinois
Public Hearing on the Proposed Granting of an Easement to Ameren Illinois Company
Across Cedar Lake Property for Electrical Transmission Lines
November 5, 2013

The City Council of the City of Carbondale, Illinois, held a public hearing on Tuesday, November 5, 2013, in City Council Chambers, 200 S. Illinois Avenue, for the purpose of soliciting comments on the proposed granting of an Easement across Cedar Lake property to Ameren Illinois Company for an existing electrical transmission power line. Mayor Fritzler called the public hearing to order at 7:10 p.m. with the following-named members of the City Council present/absent:

The notice of the proposed granting of an easement was published in the *Southern Illinoisan* on October 23, 2013. City Manager Kevin Baity presented the background of the item. The City and Shawnee Surveying and Consulting, Inc., acting as an agent for Ameren Illinois, are working together to formalize a permanent easement for the existing transmission line crossing Cedar Lake property.

Mayor Fritzler invited comments or questions from the public, but no one indicated a desire to speak on this issue.

There being no comments or questions at this hearing, Mayor Fritzler declared the public hearing closed at 7:12 p.m.
