



LOCAL LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION
April 22, 2014

The Local Liquor Control Commission held a meeting on Tuesday, April 22, 2014, in City Council Chambers, Room 108 of the Civic Center, 200 S. Illinois Avenue. Chairman Donald Monty called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. with the following-named members of the Commission present/absent:

1. Roll Call

Also present were City Clerk Jennifer Sorrell, City Manager Kevin Baity, and various members of City Staff.

2. Approval of Minutes

Commissioner Harvey moved, Commissioner McDaniel seconded, to approve the minutes from March 25, 2014. DISCUSSION: None. VOTE: All voted Aye. Motion declared carried.

3. Consideration of an application for a Class C2 Liquor License (Grocery Store- Wine and Beer in Original Package) from Aldi, Inc., d/b/a Aldi at 1232 East Main Street

Commissioner Fronabarger moved, Commissioner Adams seconded, to approve the Class C2 liquor license for Aldi, Inc., d/b/a Aldi at 1232 East Main Street contingent upon receipt of all outstanding items and the consideration of the location of the liquor display within the store. DISCUSSION: D. Monty communicated the only issue to be considered in the issuance of this license would be the placement of alcohol in the store in terms of meeting City code requirements. He further stated he would work with Aldi's to find a suitable solution. Aldi's District Manager, Jim Mittrucker informed Council Aldi would like to comply with the City code. C. McDaniel inquired about other Aldi locations. VOTE: Ayes: J. Adams, L. Fronabarger, J. Bradshaw, and D. Monty. Nays: C. Harvey and C. McDaniel.
Motion declared carried.

Gary Mileur 820 W. Mill Street expressed his objection of alcohol being allowed within Aldi.
