Public Hearing on Proposed Vacation of a Sanitary Sewer Easement Located within the
Reserve at Saluki Pointe Apartment Complex at 500 Saluki Boulevard
June 10, 2014

The City Council of the City of Carbondale, Illinois, held a public hearing on Tuesday, June 10, 2014, in City Council Chambers, 200 S. Illinois Avenue, for the purpose of soliciting comments on the proposed vacation of a sanitary sewer easement located at 500 Saluki Boulevard. Acting Mayor Monty called the public hearing to order at 8:28 p.m. with the following-named members of the City Council present/absent:

Also present were Deputy City Clerk Alicia Burtley, City Manager Kevin Baity, and various members of the City's administrative staff.

The notice of the public hearing was published in the *Southern Illinoisan* on May 25, 2014. City Manager Kevin Baity presented the background of the item. EDR Carbondale, LLC is requesting the vacation of an unused portion of a sanitary sewer easement located within the Reserve at Saluki Pointe apartment complex. The easement was dedicated on September 19, 2007, and upon completion of Phase II of the property, it was realized that the completed building encroached upon a portion of this easement which did not contain sanitary sewer lines.

Acting Mayor Monty invited comments or questions from the public. No one indicated a desire to speak on this matter.

There being no comments or questions at this hearing, Acting Mayor Monty declared the public hearing closed at 8:29 p.m.
