



## LOCAL LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION June 10, 2014

The Local Liquor Control Commission held a meeting on Tuesday, June 10, 2014, in City Council Chambers, Room 108 of the Civic Center, 200 S. Illinois Avenue. Chairman Donald Monty called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m. with the following-named members of the Commission present/absent:

### 1. Roll Call

Present: Commissioner Jessica Bradshaw, Commissioner Carolin Harvey, Commissioner Jane Adams, Commissioner Lee Fronabarger, Commissioner Corene McDaniel, and Chairman Donald Monty

Also present was Deputy City Clerk Alicia Burtley, City Manager Kevin Baity, and various members of City Staff.

### 2. Approval of Minutes from April 22, 2014

Commissioner Harvey moved, Commissioner Adams seconded, to approve the minutes from April 22, 2014. DISCUSSION: None. VOTE: Ayes: J. Bradshaw, C. Harvey, J. Adams, L. Fronabarger, C. McDaniel and D. Monty. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

### 3. Consideration of an Application for a Class A2 BG Liquor License (All alcoholic liquor by the drink for consumption on premises with Beer Garden/Outdoor Café) from Nytefire Ventures, LLC, d/b/a Underground Barrel Room and Grill at 717 South University

Commissioner Adams moved, Commissioner Fronabarger seconded, to approve the Class A2 BG liquor license to Nytefire Ventures, LLC d/b/a Underground Barrel Room, pending receipt of all outstanding items. DISCUSSION: Commissioner Monty commended the applicant on how precise the business proposal was presented in the application. VOTE: Ayes: J. Bradshaw, C. Harvey, J. Adams, L. Fronabarger, C. McDaniel and D. Monty. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

### 4. Consideration of Third Quarter Reports from the Police Department, Fire Department, and Building and Neighborhood Services for License Year 2013-2014

Commissioner Bradshaw moved, Commissioner McDaniel seconded, to accept and place on file the Third Quarter Reports. DISCUSSION: Commissioner Adams pointed out a technicality in the action request and the infraction of selling alcohol to inebriated individuals. Chief of Police O'Guinn stated this infraction is not a regular occurrence. VOTE: Ayes: J. Bradshaw, C. Harvey, J. Adams, L. Fronabarger, C. McDaniel and D. Monty. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

### 5. Consideration of Liquor License Renewal Applications for the 2014-2015 License Year

Commissioner Bradshaw moved, Commissioner Harvey seconded, to approve the renewal of all liquor licenses pending receipt of outstanding items. DISCUSSION: Commissioner Adams inquired about Global Gourmet's liquor classification. Chairman Monty shared his concerns with restaurants functioning like bars and suggested looking into the city code to make more of a distinction. City Clerk J. Sorrell responded accordingly. VOTE: Ayes: J. Bradshaw, C. Harvey, J. Adams, L. Fronabarger, C. McDaniel and D. Monty. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

**6. Citizens Comments and Questions**

Lance Jack, 611 S. Illinois Avenue stated he would like the Commission to give more thought into developing a classification for those individuals who only want to obtain video gaming privileges.
