



LOCAL LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION September 30, 2014

The Local Liquor Control Commission held a meeting on Tuesday, September 30, 2014, in City Council Chambers, Room 108 of the Civic Center, 200 S. Illinois Avenue. Chairman Donald Monty called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with the following-named members of the Commission present/absent:

1. Roll Call

2. Approval of Minutes from August 26, 2014

3. Consideration of an Application for a Class A1 Liquor License for Sen Fuy's, Inc. d/b/a New Kahala Fast Foods at 600 East Grand Avenue, Suite 3

J. Bradshaw moved, L. Fronabarger seconded, to approve the issuance of a Class A1 liquor license for Sen Fuy's, Inc. d/b/a New Kahala Fast Foods at 600 East Grand Avenue, Suite 3, pending receipt of all outstanding items. DISCUSSION: None. VOTE: Ayes: J. Bradshaw, C. Harvey, J. Adams, L. Fronabarger, C. McDaniel, and D. Monty. Nays: None. Motion declared carried. C. Harvey asked why applicants have outstanding items when they are aware those items will be needed. The City Clerk responded to the query.

4. Citizens' Comments and Questions

Chairman Monty commented on the appearance of a restaurant on South Illinois Avenue operating as a bar. He remarked on the requirement for restaurant liquor licenses City Code have a minimum percentage requirement from the sale of food and nonalcoholic beverages and sales of alcohol must accompany a meal. Mr. Monty stated that the location was included in the lineup of a bar crawl, as was indicated on the participants' t-shirts, and noted that if the public perception of La Fogata is that it is a bar, there is an issue. Chairman Monty indicated that he would like the owner to speak to the Commission about the conduct of the business and to exercise the provision of the City Code to require the business to provide a statement showing its breakout of revenues by food and other items. Commissioner Adams asked if approval from the Commission was required.

There being no further business to come before the Local Liquor Control Commission, Chairman Monty declared the meeting adjourned at 7:12 p.m.
