



LOCAL LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION March 24, 2015

The Local Liquor Control Commission held a meeting on Tuesday, March 24, 2015, in City Council Chambers, Room 108 of the Civic Center, 200 S. Illinois Avenue. Chairman Donald Monty called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m. with the following-named members of the Commission present/absent:

1. Roll Call

2. Approval of Minutes from March 3, 2015

J. Adams moved, C. Harvey seconded, to approve the minutes of March 3, 2015. DISCUSSION: None. VOTE: Ayes: C. Harvey, J. Adams, L. Fronabarger, C. McDaniel, J. Bradshaw, and D. Monty. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

3. Application to transfer an existing Class A2 liquor license (Restaurant - all alcoholic liquors) from Nytefire Ventures, LLC, d/b/a Underground Barrel Room & Grill, at 717 South University Avenue to Krazy Venture, LLC

L. Fronabarger moved, J. Bradshaw seconded, to approve the transfer of an existing Class A2 license from Nytefire Ventures, LLC, to Krazy Venture, LLC, pending receipt of all outstanding items. VOTE: Ayes: C. Harvey, J. Adams, L. Fronabarger, C. McDaniel, J. Bradshaw, and D. Monty. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

4. Application for a Class B3 liquor license (Video Gaming Establishment with On-Premises Consumption) for SOILL Adventure, LLC d/b/a Lacey's Place at 715 North Giant City Road

Ting Ni, Pinckneyville, was present to respond to questions from the Local Liquor Control Commission. D. Monty noted that the applicant has no experience with the liquor business, but that she would be traveling to Champaign to train in video gaming facilities and Ms. Ni agreed. Ms. Ni indicated that the source of capital for the venture will be solely hers and that she has no investors at this point. D. Monty asked the applicant to explain how, given her lack of experience in the liquor business, she feels confident in her ability to operate this facility. Ms. Ni noted her experience in the restaurant industry and the assistance and training she will receive from the Lacey's Place of Champaign. D. Monty then remarked on the applicant residing outside of the City and asked about her appointment of a resident manager.

J. Adams moved, C. McDaniel seconded, to approve the issuance of a Class B3 license for SOILL Adventure, LLC d/b/a Lacey's Place at 715 North Giant City Road, contingent upon receipt of all outstanding items. VOTE: Ayes: C. Harvey, J. Adams, L. Fronabarger, C. McDaniel, and J. Bradshaw. Nays: D. Monty. Motion declared carried.
