Public Hearing on Proposed FY 2016 City Budget
April 14, 2015

The City Council of the City of Carbondale, Illinois, held a public hearing on Tuesday, April 14, 2015, in City Council Chambers, 200 S. Illinois Avenue, for the purpose of soliciting comments on the proposed FY 2016 Budget.
