Background and Summary:

A Budget Adjustment is necessary to increase the overall FY 2015 Tax Increment Fund #1 budget for unexpected items.

The budget adjustment is needed to provide budgetary funds for the disbursement of TIF increment for the construction of a parking lot at 213 E. Main St. This item was not anticipated to be completed in FY 2015 and no funds were included for the disbursement in the original FY 2015 budget. The project was completed by the developer and therefore subject to reimbursement per TIF guidelines.

Recommended Action:

It is recommended that the City Council adopt an Ordinance Authorizing a Budget Adjustment to increase the overall Fiscal Year 2015 Budget for Fund overages.

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-____

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A BUDGET ADJUSTMENTS TO INCREASE THE OVERALL FISCAL YEAR 2015 BUDGET FOR FUND OVERAGES

WHEREAS, the City of Carbondale, Illinois, is a home rule unit of local government under the Illinois Constitution, 1970, Article VII, Section 6; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article VII, Section 6(a), of the Illinois Constitution, 1970, the City of Carbondale may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs including, but not limited to, the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the construction of a parking lot at 213 E. Main Street was unexpectedly completed in FY2015; and

WHEREAS, no funds were included in the FY2015 budget for the construction of the parking lot; and

WHEREAS, City has determined that a budget adjustment be made to increase the overall Fiscal Year 2015 budget for fund overages, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Carbondale finds it in the best interest of the City of Carbondale to accept the adjusted Fiscal Year 2015 budget as set out in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARBONDALE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council deems it in the best interest of the citizens of Carbondale to authorize the City Manager to adopt the budget adjustments to the FY2015 budget, as set out in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. That the FY2015 budget is hereby increased for unexpected items, as set out in the budget adjustment in the total amount of \$44,443 as shown in Exhibit “A” and such funds are hereby appropriated in accordance with the law for the purposes of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager of the City of Carbondale is hereby authorized to take any and all reasonable, necessary, and proper action to carry out the intent and purposes of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to increase the FY2015 budget in accordance with this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. That all ordinances and parts thereof in conflict herewith are expressly repealed and are of no other force and effect.

SECTION 6. That repeal of any ordinance by this Ordinance shall not affect any rights accrued or liability incurred under said repealed ordinance to the effective date hereof. The provisions of this Ordinance insofar as they are the same or substantially the same as those of any prior ordinance, shall be construed as a continuation of said prior ordinances.

SECTION 7. That it is the intention of the City Council of the City of Carbondale that this Ordinance and every provision thereof shall be considered separable, and the invalidity of any section, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other portion of this Ordinance.

SECTION 8. That the City Council of the City of Carbondale finds that the subject matter of this Ordinance pertains to the government and affairs of the City of Carbondale and is passed pursuant to authorities granted it by State statutes and the Home Rule powers of the City of Carbondale pursuant to the provisions of Article VII, Section 6(a) of the Illinois Constitution.

SECTION 9. That this Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage, approval, recording, and publication in pamphlet form in accordance with law.
