

# REQUEST FOR LOCAL LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION ACTION

**DATE:** May 19, 2015

**ITEM NO. 3** - Application for a Class F1 Liquor License for Carbondale Main Street's Concert on June 6, 2015, to be held on West Monroe Street between South Illinois Avenue and South University Avenue

Attached is an application from Carbondale Main Street for a Class F1 liquor license (temporary license allowing sales of beer and wine only) for an event to be held on a portion of the parking lot west of Carbondale City Hall and on a section of West Monroe Street between South Illinois Avenue and South University Avenue. This area is more clearly defined in the attached diagram. The referenced section of West Monroe Street would be closed to vehicular traffic upon approval by the City Manager of a Street Closure Application.

Class F1 licenses are requested to allow the consumption of beer and wine in non-glass containers, which consumption has been requested for the hours of 5:00 p.m. until 11:00 p.m. on Saturday, June 6, 2015. A Fair Days Resolution is not required to allow public consumption of alcohol for events where a Class F1 or F2 liquor license is issued and public consumption of alcohol is allowed by the Liquor Commission's approval of the license within the defined controlled space.

**Liquor Code:** Temporary liquor licenses are limited to charitable and/or not-for-profit organizations. Carbondale Main Street has provided documentation of its not-for-profit status. There is nothing else in the Liquor Code which would expressly preclude issuance of this license.

**Liquor Advisory Board review:** Due to an insufficient amount of time to consider this item prior to the event date, the Liquor Advisory Board did not review this application during a regular meeting. However, the members of the Board were polled individually and recommended approval of this item.

**Outstanding items:** The outstanding items are the license fee and proof of dram shop insurance.

## **Recommended Action:**

The Local Liquor Control Commission may:

- (1) Approve the issuance of a Class F1 liquor license to Carbondale Main Street for Saturday, June 6, 2015, contingent upon receipt of outstanding items; or
- (2) Deny the issuance of a Class F1 liquor license to Carbondale Main Street based on one or more of the provisions of the Liquor Code.
