## LOCAL LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION May 19, 2015

The Local Liquor Control Commission held a meeting on Tuesday, May, 19, 2015, in City Council Chambers, Room 108 of the Civic Center, 200 S. Illinois Avenue. Chairman John “Mike” Henry called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m. with the following-named members of the Commission present/absent:

### 1. Roll Call

Present: Commissioner Jessica Bradshaw, Commissioner Carolin Harvey, Commissioner Lee Fronabarger, Commissioner Tom Grant, Commissioner Adam Loos, and Chairman John M. Henry

Absent: Councilman Navreet Kang

Also present were City Clerk Jennifer Sorrell, City Manager Kevin Baity, and various members of City Staff.

### 2. Approval of Minutes from April 14, 2015

L. Fronabarger moved, A. Loos seconded, to approve the minutes of April 14, 2015. DISCUSSION: None. VOTE: Ayes: J. Bradshaw, C. Harvey, L. Fronabarger, T. Grant, A. Loos, and J. Henry. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

### 3. Application for a Class F1 Liquor License (Temporary License Issued Only to Non-Profit Organizations – Beer and Wine Sales Only) for Carbondale Main Street’s Concert on June 6, 2015, to be held on West Monroe Street between South Illinois Avenue and South University Avenue

J. Bradshaw moved, C. Harvey seconded, to approve the issuance of a Class F1 liquor license to Carbondale Main Street for Saturday, June 6, 2015, contingent upon receipt of outstanding items.

DISCUSSION: The Commission asked about the history of issuing licenses to Main Street, fencing-in of the area where alcohol will be present, and remarked on the performers for the event.

VOTE: Ayes: J. Bradshaw, C. Harvey, L. Fronabarger, T. Grant, A. Loos, and J. Henry. Nays: None. Motion declared carried.

### 4. Application for a Class B3 liquor license (Video Gaming Establishment with On-Premises Consumption) for MLK Enterprises, LLC d/b/a Triple Sevens at 105 South Washington Street

DISCUSSION: Attorney John Schneider represented the applicant and inquired about the Commission’s receipt of an explanatory letter from the applicant. The City Clerk and City Attorney replied to Local Liquor Control Commission inquiries. Mr. Schneider and Mr. Richard Brizendine responded to questions from the Commission and provided elaboration on responses included in the application and supplemental documents. Commissioners provided their individual remarks, comments in support of or opposition to the application, or concerns relating to this agenda item.

T. Grant moved, C. Harvey seconded, to approve the issuance of a Class B3 liquor license for MLK Enterprises, LLC d/b/a Triple Sevens at 105 South Washington Street, contingent upon receipt of outstanding items. VOTE: Ayes: T. Grant and J. Henry. Nays: J. Bradshaw, C. Harvey, L. Fronabarger, and A. Loos. Motion to approve does not carry.
