

City Council of the City of Carbondale, Illinois
Public Hearing on Proposed Sale/Donation of City-owned Property Located
At 410 East Chestnut and 411 East Birch Street to Common Greens, Inc.
August 11, 2015

The City Council of the City of Carbondale, Illinois, held a public hearing on Tuesday, August 11, 2015, in City Council Chambers, 200 S. Illinois Avenue, for the purpose of soliciting comments on the proposed sale/donation of real estate at 410 East Chestnut and 411 East Birch Streets to enable the development of a community garden complex. Mayor Henry called the public hearing to order at 7:05 p.m. with the following-named members of the City Council present/absent:

Common Greens, a not-for-profit corporation is requesting the donation of the vacant parcel in order to develop a community garden. The valuation of the parcel in question has been set at \$3,500.00.

Mayor Henry invited comments or questions from the public. There were no citizens who wished to speak.

There being no comments or questions at this hearing, Mayor Henry declared the public hearing closed at 7:07 p.m.
