RESOLUTION NO. 2022-R- 25

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022 RURAL SURFACE TRANSPORTATION GRANT FUNDS

WHEREAS, the City of Carbondale has been undertaking many efforts to improve the transportation infrastructure in Carbondale; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Carbondale completed a pavement management plan in 2017 which rates the quality of all streets in the community; and,

WHEREAS, the approved community investment plan doesn't have the necessary funding resources to make all necessary street repairs in the community; and,

WHEREAS, on March 22 the United States Department of Transportation announced that \$2.9 billion of funding was made available through the federal infrastructure law passed in 2021; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Transportation created the Rural Surface Transportation Grant program to help rural communities apply for funding to improve transportation infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, City of Carbondale staff have developed a project to improve Giant City Road, Marion Street, Oak Street, a portion of Pleasant Hill Road, Poplar Street, and Washington Street; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of this project is \$9,557,131; and

WHEREAS, a rural infrastructure grant would fund 80% (\$7,645,705) of the project with required matching funds of 20% (\$1,911,426).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARBONDALE, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council approves a submission of a 2022 USDOT Rural Surface Transportation Grant under the guidelines of the U.S. Department of Transportation and shall enter into and agree to the understandings and assurances governing the application for, receipt and utilization of the aforesaid grant funds.

SECTION 2. The City Manager is authorized to provide such additional information as may be required to accomplish the obtaining of a grant offer.

SECTION 3. The City of Carbondale shall and does hereby commit 20% local matching funds in the estimated amount of \$1,911,426 as required for the Rural Surface Transportation Grant.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution be spread at length upon the minute records of the City Council of the City of Carbondale, Illinois.

SECTION 5. That this Resolution shall take effect upon its passage, approval, recording, and publication in pamphlet form in accordance with law.
